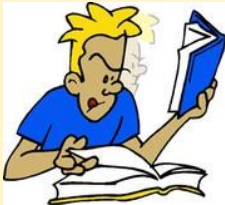

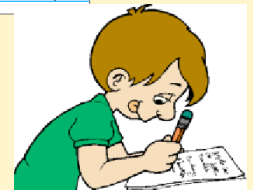
Do you find it difficult to help your child to spell?
