Top tips from coffee mornings... How to help your child sleep well

1. Sleep rests the brain and body. It is when our body grows and repairs itself.
 2. Poor sleep affects the ability for our brain to function and make memories—we need this to learn!
 3. Did you know that we need this many hours sleep every day?

- **Child under 5 = 12 to 16 hours**
 - **Child aged 5-11 = 10 hours**
 - **Adults = 7 to 8 hours**
4. Turn off and remove all electronic devices an hour before bed and have 'wind down' time, including reading a book.
 5. Set the same bedtime everyday so that it becomes a routine.

A message from the Kilburn Community Police:



We have had a number of mobile phone snatches reported to Police over last few days within the Kilburn ward area. The suspects have been on mopeds whilst committing the offences. Majority of the offences have been on **West End Lane NW6 and Kilburn High Road NW6**. Watch out for bikes and mopeds, especially if they mount the pavement. If they could grab your phone as they ride by, stop using it and put it away. Don't text while you're walking—you will be less aware of what is around you.
